Jason Escape travels complete with everything needed to perform his show.

- If Jason Escape is performing his aerial show then a ceiling height of no less than 21 feet is required. Also, level ground is a *must*.
- Jason Escape is fully insured.
- An adequate sound system for his headset microphone must be provided for audiences over 100 people.
- A mic and stand should also be provided.
- Inputs for audio should be provided as well.
- A knowledgeable person to run the sound should be provided.
- If this is a night performance, sufficient lighting must be provided.
- For pre performances: water, coffee, towels and a healthy meal/snacks.
